The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 2(37)_011(B)/64 dated 27.11.1965 on the above subject and to state that for para 2(c) and notes introduced vide ADDANDUM No. F.2(91)-E.II(B)/66 dated 1.2.1967, the following shall be substituted:-2(c). "Family means a Government servant's wife/ husband, children and other persons residing with and wholly dependent upon him/her. A husband/wife/child/parent having an independent source of income is not treated as a member belonging to the family of the Government servant except when such income including pension (inclusive of temporary increase in pension and pension equivalent of death-cumretirement benefits) does not exceed Rs.100 per month. These orders would take effect from 1st May, 1967. 2. 3.
