Opening of a new Object Head 'Grants for creation of capital assets' and amending the nomenclature of the existing Object Head viz. '31-Grantsin-aid' to read as 'Grants-in-aid General' in the list of Object Heads below Rule 8 of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1978.

With the objective of uniquely depicting the expenditure on Grants for creation of capital assets at the level of primary unit of appropriation, it has been decided, with immediate effect (Financial year 2009-10), to open a new object head 'Grants for creation of capital assets', in addition to the list of existing object heads, as codified through this Department's OM No F. 1(47)-E.II(A)/94 dated 12.12.1994, as modified from time to time.

The new object head 'Grants for creation of capital assets' will be included in the list of Object Heads indicated below Government of India Decision No.1 below Rule 8 of Delegation of Financial Power Rules, 1978. The Object Head Number, the code and the description/definition of Object head 'Grants for creation of capital assets' would be as follows:-
