OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revision of selection grade pay scale for Group 'D' industrial workers in the ordinary grade scale of Rs.196-232.

.....

The undersigned is directed to say that this Ministry's O.M. dated 10-1-1977 for grant of Selection Grade to Group 'C' and 'D' employees inter alia provides that the selection grade scale should end short of the maximum of the scale of the next promotional post. In this context, Staff side in the National Council (JCM) made a demand that the selection grade scale for Group 'D' industrial workers working in the ordinary grade scale of Rs.196-232 should be Rs.210-270 since the pay scale of their next promotional post is Rs.210-290.

2. The matter had been under consideration of the Government. In the meeting of the National Council (JCM) held on 11-7-1985, it was decided to accept this demand. Accordingly, the President is pleased to decide that the selection grade scale for Group 'D' industrial workers (in the ordinary grade scale of Rs.196-232) should be Rs.210-270, provided the scale of the immediate promotional post is Rs.210-290.

3. These orders will take effect from the date of issue.
