OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Transfer of Central Government Employees to other Governments Departments, Companies, Corporations etc. - Deputation (duty) allowance.

In accordance with Paragraph 1(VI) of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.10(24)-Est.III/60 dated the 4th May, 1961, the deputation (duty) allowance admissible to an officer placed on deputation shall be so restricted that the basic pay of the employee in his parent department from time to time plus the deputation (duty) allowance does not exceed the maximum of the scale of pay of the post held on deputation. A question has, however, arisen as to how the above restriction may be applied in respect of a Central Government employee whose pay has been revised with reference to the recommendations of the Second Pay Commission is deputed to State Governments/Companies etc. where the pay scales have not been so revised. It has been decided in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor-General of India that in such cases the basic pay of the officer in his parent

department from time to time plus the deputation (duty) allowance plus Dearness allowance, if any admissible, should not exceed the maximum of the scale of pay of the post held on deputation in the State Government/ Company plus Dearness allowance admissible on that pay under the relevant State/ Company rules.
