OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Grant of *ad-hoc* bonus to the Central Government employees-removal of eligibility wage ceiling for Group C and D employees for 1995-96.

Reference is invited to the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's O.M.No. 14(1)-E (Coord)/95 dated the 20th September, 1995 and para 2 of O.M. No.14(1)-E.(Coord.)/96 dated the 17th October, 1996 wherein the eligibility wage ceiling of Rs.3500/- has been prescribed for grant of *ad-hoc* bonus to the Central Government employees. The President is now pleased to decide that *ad-hoc* bonus shall be paid to all Central Government employees in Group C & D without any eligibility wage ceiling for the accounting year 1995-96. The calculation ceiling of Rs.2500/- will, however, remain unchanged.

2. In so far as the persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Departments are concerned, these orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
