Subject: - Anomalies as a result of application of orders contained in this Ministry's O.M.No.F.1(9)-E.III
(A)/74 dated 23-3-74.

The undersigned is directed to invite a reference to this Ministry's 0.M. montioned above which permits the fixation of pay under FR 22-C in respect of employees drawing maximum of the scale in the lower post on promotion to higher post with reference to notional pay arrived at after adding one increment above the maximum of the lower scale (equivalent to the amount of the last increment in that scale) with effect from 1-11-73. These caders were issued on the basis of recommendations of Third Pay Commission.

- that issue of the aforesaid orders has resulted in an anomaly to the effect that seniors promoted before 1-11-73 are getting on or after 1-11-73.
- In order to remove the above anomaly, the President is pleased to decide that in such cases, the pay of the senior officer should be stepped up to a figure equal to the pay as after 1-11-73. The stepping up should be done with effect be subject to the following conditions:-
 - (a) Both the junior and senior officer should belong to the same cadre and the posts in which they have been promoted should be identical and in the same cadre
 - (b) The scales of pay of the lower and higher posts in which they are entitled to draw pay should be identical; and
 - (c) The anomaly should be directly as a result of application of orders contained in this Ministry!

- The orders re-fixing the pay of the senior officer in accordance with the aforesaid decision should be issued under R. 27 and the next increment of the senior officer will be drawn on completion of the required qualifying service with effect from the date of re-fixation of pay. The arrears of pay as a result of re-fixation of pay would be admissible from the date the pay of the senior person is
