N O T I F I C A T I O N

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309, and clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and of all other powers enabling him in this behalf and after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor-General in relation to persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, the President hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the Civil Service Regulations, namely:-

1. (1) These Regulations may be called the Civil Service \_\_\_\_\_ (Amendment) Regulations, 1971.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. In the Civil Service Regulations:-
  - (a) in Article 525, the following shall be inserted at the end, namely:-

" His pension for service in the Civil Department will not be affected by his military pension.";
  - (b) in Article 529, the Note shall be omitted.
3. (1) Where a military pensioner on his employment in a qualifying service in a Civil Department had elected to retain his military pension and had retired from civil service on or after the 27th March, 1967, the date when Article 529 of the Civil Service Regulations was amended by the insertion of a Note thereto,-
  - (a) the amount of the Civil pension sanctioned to him, if it had been restricted under Article 530 of the Civil Service Regulations, shall be reviewed, or
  - (b) a separate pension for his civil service, if it had not been settled before the commencement of the Civil Service \_\_\_\_\_ (Amendment) Regulations, 1971, shall be settled, as if the Note to Article 529 of the Civil Service Regulations had not been in force at the relevant date.

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2. Any pension reviewed or settled under sub-clause (a), or, as the case may be, under sub-clause (b), of clause (1) shall take effect from the date the military pensioner retired from civil service.
