OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Fixation of pay of Civil pensioners on re-employment - Raising of limit of exemption of pension.

The undersigned is directed to invite reference to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.5(14)-E.III(B)/77, dated the 19th July, 1978 according to which pension upto Rs.125/- is being ignored in fixation of pay on re-employment of persons retiring before attaining the age of 55 years and to say that the Ministry of Defence issued orders in their O.M.No.2(1)/83/-D(Civ.I), dated the 8th February, 1983 to the effect that the limit of pension to be ignored in fixing of pay on re-employment of Ex-servicemen, retiring before attaining the age of 55 years, will be raised to Rs.250/- in the case of Service officers and that the entire pension will be ignored in the case of personnel below Commissioned Officers' rank.

2. The question of issuing similar orders to raise the limit of pension to be ignored in respect of Civil pensioners has been under the consideration of Government of India. The president has been pleased to decide that in the case of Civil pensioners retiring before attaining the age of 55 years, the pension as indicated below may be ignored in fixing their pay on re-employment in the Central Civil Departments:-

(i) In the case of officers holding Group 'A' posts at the time of their retirement, first Rs.250/- of pension;

(ii) In the case of officers holding Group 'B' or lower post at the time of their retirement, the entire pension.

3. The pension for the purpose of these orders includes pension equivalent of gratuity and other forms of retirement benefits.

4. These orders will take effect from 25th January, 1983 and the existing limits of Civil pensions to be ignored in fixing pay of re-employed pensioners will,

therefore, cease to be applicable to cases of such pensioners as are re-employed on or after that date. In the case of the persons who are already on re-employment, the pay may be re-fixed on the basis of these orders with immediate effect provided they opt to come under these orders. If they do not opt, their terms would be determined afresh as if they have been re-employed for the first time from the date of these orders.

5. The option should be exercised in writing within a period of six months from the date of issue of these orders. The option once exercised shall be final.

6. The Ex-Servicemen re-employed in Central Civil Departments on retirement before attaining the age of 55 years are to be governed by the orders issued by the Ministry of Defence vide their O.M.No.2(1)/83/D(Civ.I), dated the 8th February, 1983.

7. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, these orders are issued in consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
