OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Instructions regarding the exercise of options by, and counting of past service for leave, pension etc. of the permanent staff taken over by the Government of India from Part 'B' States.

The undersigned is directed to refer to para 2 of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.16(2)E.III/52 dated 18.2.1952, on the subject noted above, and to say that it has been decided that the permanent ex-Part B States staff who have opted to be and are still governed by the pre-absorption scales of pay, allowances and other conditions of service may be allowed a fresh option to come on to the Central Government of scales of pay, allowances and other conditions of service.

2. These orders will take effect from the date of issue. In the case of an ex-Part B State employee who opts for the Central Government scale of pay, allowances and other conditions of service, the pay will be fixed in the Central Government scale under the provisions of F.R.22(a)(i) with immediate effect and he will be governed by the Central Government rules and orders and other conditions of service in all matters as from the date he is brought on to the Central scale.

3. The option should be exercised in writing within a period of three months from the date of issue of these orders. The option, once exercised, shall be final.

4. In so far as the persons taken over by the Indian Audit and Accounts Department are concerned, the orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
