OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Transfer of Central Govt. Employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations, etc., Deputation (duty) allowance,

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
The undersigned is directed to state that for sometime past the question whether the facility of a House peon or cash compensation in lieu thereof allowed by certain State Governments to their employees should also be admissible to the Central Govt. Employees transferred on deputation to these Governments has been under consideration.

2. Attention may be invited, in this connection, to the standard terms of deputation laid down in Annexure to this Ministry's O.M. No. F.1(6)-E.IV(A)/62 dt. 7.12.62. It would be observed from item (4) thereof that local allowances like Compensatory (city) allowance and House Rent allowance in such cases is to be regulated under the rules of the borrowing Governments. The President is now pleased to decide that the facility of a house peon or cash compensation in lieu thereof sanctioned by the respective State Governments is in the nature of a compensatory allowance and the Central Government Employees on deputation to these Governments will also be entitled to the said benefit to the extent the rules of the said State Government concerned permit.

3. This order will also apply mutatis mutandis to the Central Govt. Employees deputed to Public Sector Undertaking wholly or substantially owned or controlled by State Governments, the regular employees of which are entitled to the concession referred to in para 2 above.

4. These orders take effect from the date of their issue.

5. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit & Accounts Department are concerned these orders have been issued after consultation with the C&A.G.
