OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960 - Regulation of increment of Stenographers belonging to the old Grade II of the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service.

The undersigned is directed to say that before the introduction of the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960, Grades II and III of the Central Secretariat Stenographers' Service carried the prescribed scale of Rs.250-10-300-15-375 and Rs.160-10-330, respectively. These Grades have been merged into a single Grade with effect from the 1st July, 1959 and a single revised scale of Rs.210-10-290-15-320-EB-15-425-EB-15-530 has been prescribed for the combined Grade. It has been brought to notice that in some cases the pay of officers who belong to old Grade II has not been correctly fixed on the revised scale and in some cases the dates of increment have not been correctly regulated.

2. It is clarified that the pay of Stenographers who were in Grade II before the 1st July, 1959, is to be fixed on the revised

scale under Rule 10(1)(ii) read with Note 1 thereunder and Rule 10(2) read with Note 1 thereunder. Their next increment will accrue on the date on which an increment would have been drawn in the old Grade II. Fixation of their pay at a higher stage under F.R. 31(2) after 1.7.59 will not have the effect of increasing the pay in the revised scale. In other words, the increase in officiating pay after 1.7.59 by the operation of F.R. 31(2) will be ignored.
