
Subject:-Grant of deputation allowance on the revised pay fixed under the C.C.S.(RP) Rules, 1960.

A question has been raised whether the deputation allowance drawn by officers deputed to other Departments, Governments, Companies, Corporations etc., which was being drawn as a percentage of grade pay (exclusive of dearness allowance) can be allowed at the same percentage of pay fixed under the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1960. The President has been pleased to decide that the deputation allowance, wherever it has been expressed as a percentage of pay, may be calculated on the pay as fixed in the revised scales from the date the revised scales have ~~become~~ applicable to the individual Government servant concerned. Any Government servant on deputation, who has elected the revised scale from a particular date, would get the deputation allowance also calculated with reference to the pay in the revised scale from that date. Arrears also may be paid in these cases.

2. The same procedure may be followed in regulating special pay also, wherever such special pay had been sanctioned as a percentage of basic pay.

3. In so far as the employees of the Indian Accounts and Audit Department are concerned these orders have been issued in consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
