OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Transfer of Central Government employees to other Governments, Departments, Companies, Corporations, etc.  
\*\*\*\*\*

The undersigned is directed to say that according to the delegation contained in Serial No.29 of Appendix 4 of the A.C.P.&T. Compilation of Fundamental and Supplementary Rules Vol.2, the power delegated to the administrative Ministries, Heads of Departments etc., to sanction transfer to foreign service in India under F.R.110(c) is subject to the conditions stipulated in serial No. 30 ibid. In this connection, reference is invited to this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. F.1(8)-E.IV(A)/62 dated the 18th June, 1962 wherein it was clarified that in the cases of foreign service which are not covered by this Ministry's Office Memorandum dated the 4th May, 1961 (viz. deputations to Municipalities, Universities etc., which are not owned or controlled by the Government) the existing delegation contained in Serial No.29 ibid will continue to apply.

2. The question of bringing all types of cases of deputation to foreign service in India within the ambit of the general orders contained in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No.F.10(24)-E.III/60 dated 4.5.61 (as amended from time to time) had been under consideration of the Central Government for sometime past and it has now been decided that the aforesaid orders will equally apply to all cases of deputation on foreign service in India (including those to Municipalities, Universities, etc.)

3. An advance copy of Correction Slip No.1060 is also enclosed.

4. These orders will apply to cases of foreign service commencing after the date of issue of this Office Memorandum and in respect of persons already on foreign service to Municipalities and Universities etc., they will not apply so long as the deputationists continue to hold the same post.

5. In so far as persons serving in the Indian Audit & Accounts Department are concerned, these orders have been issued after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India.
